THE HORSE'S BODY

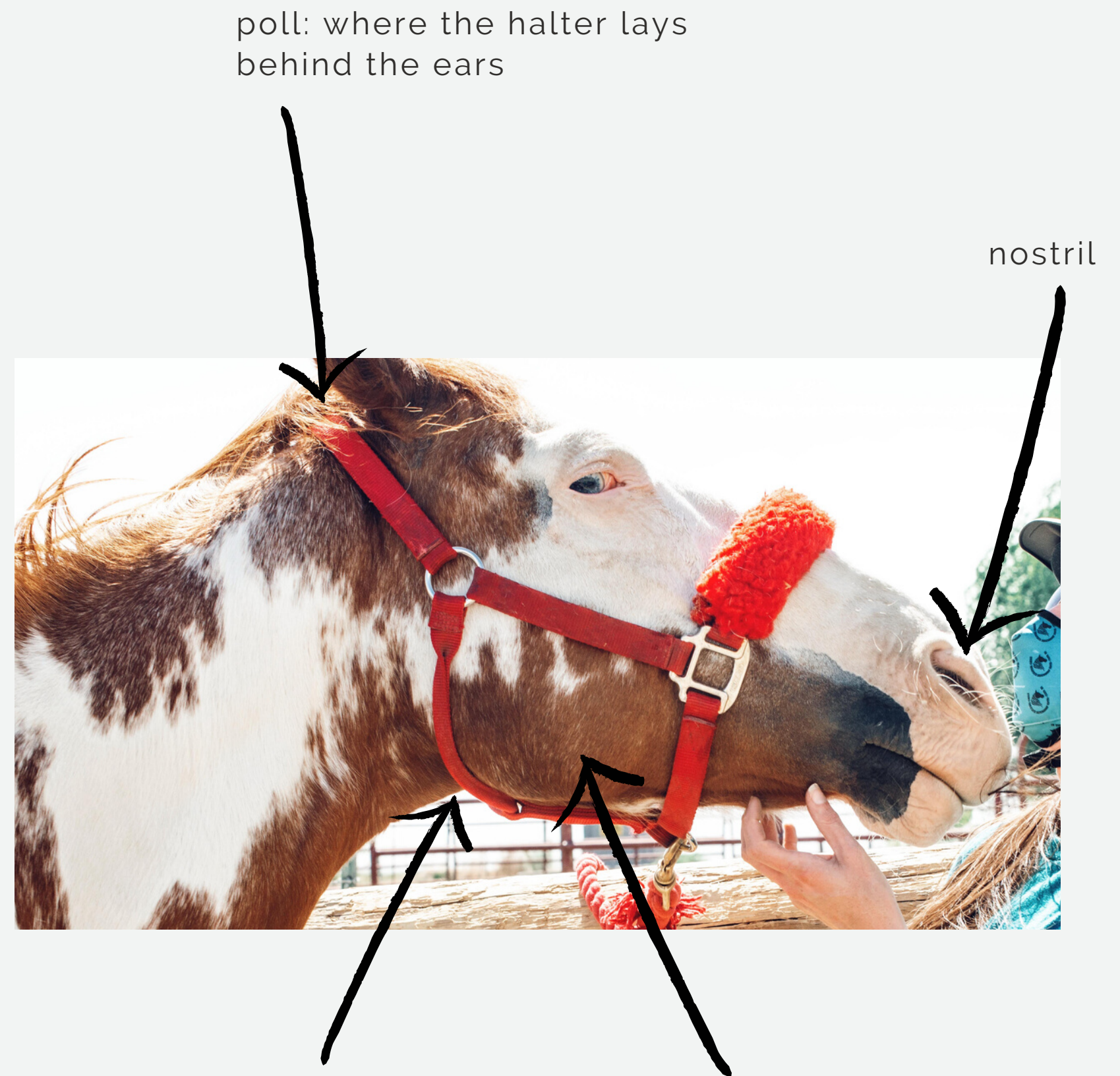
Equestrians can speak what seems like a foreign language at times. Learning the names of the horse's body parts can help us communicate more effectively with one another.

jaw meets the neck

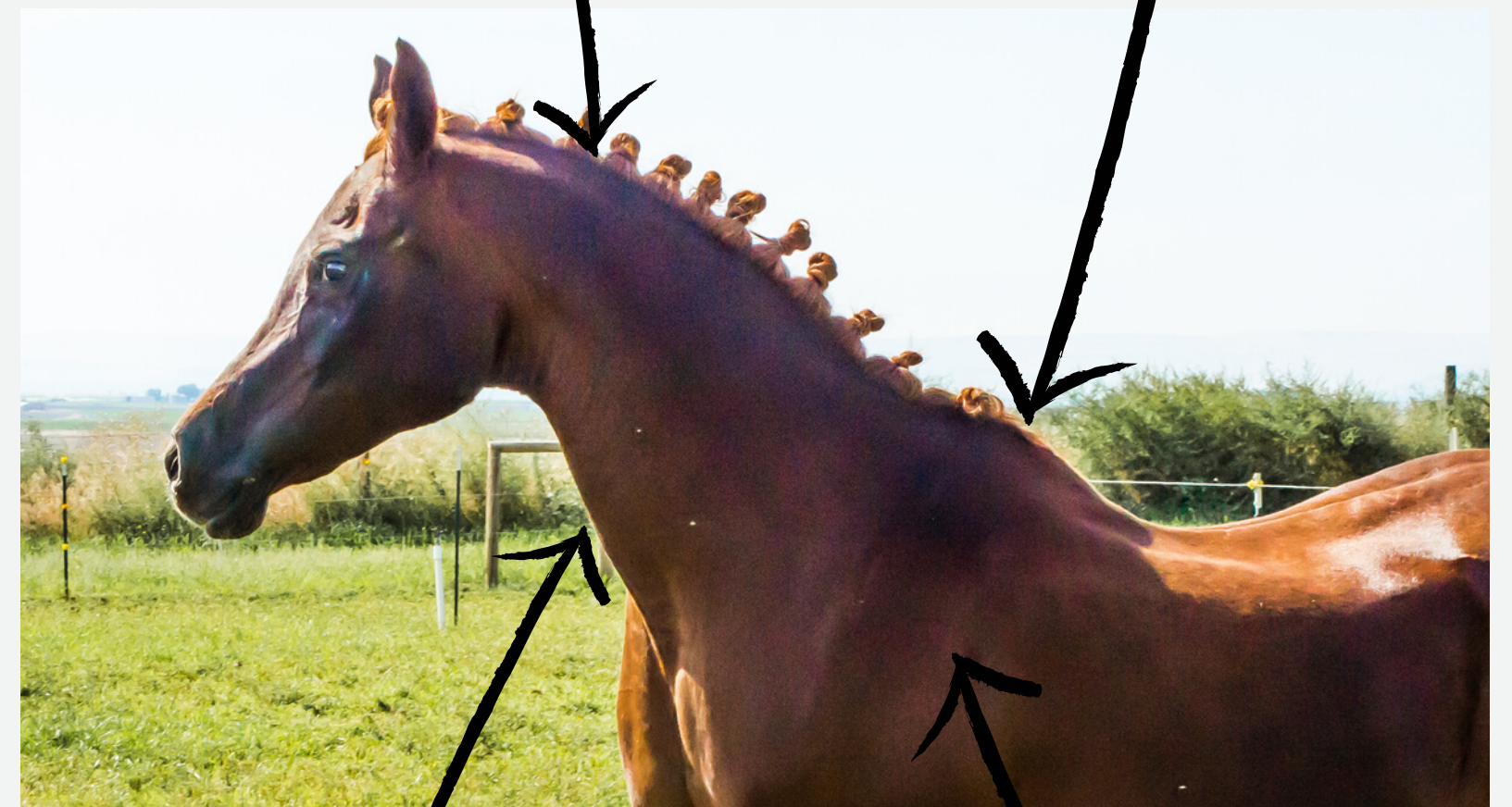

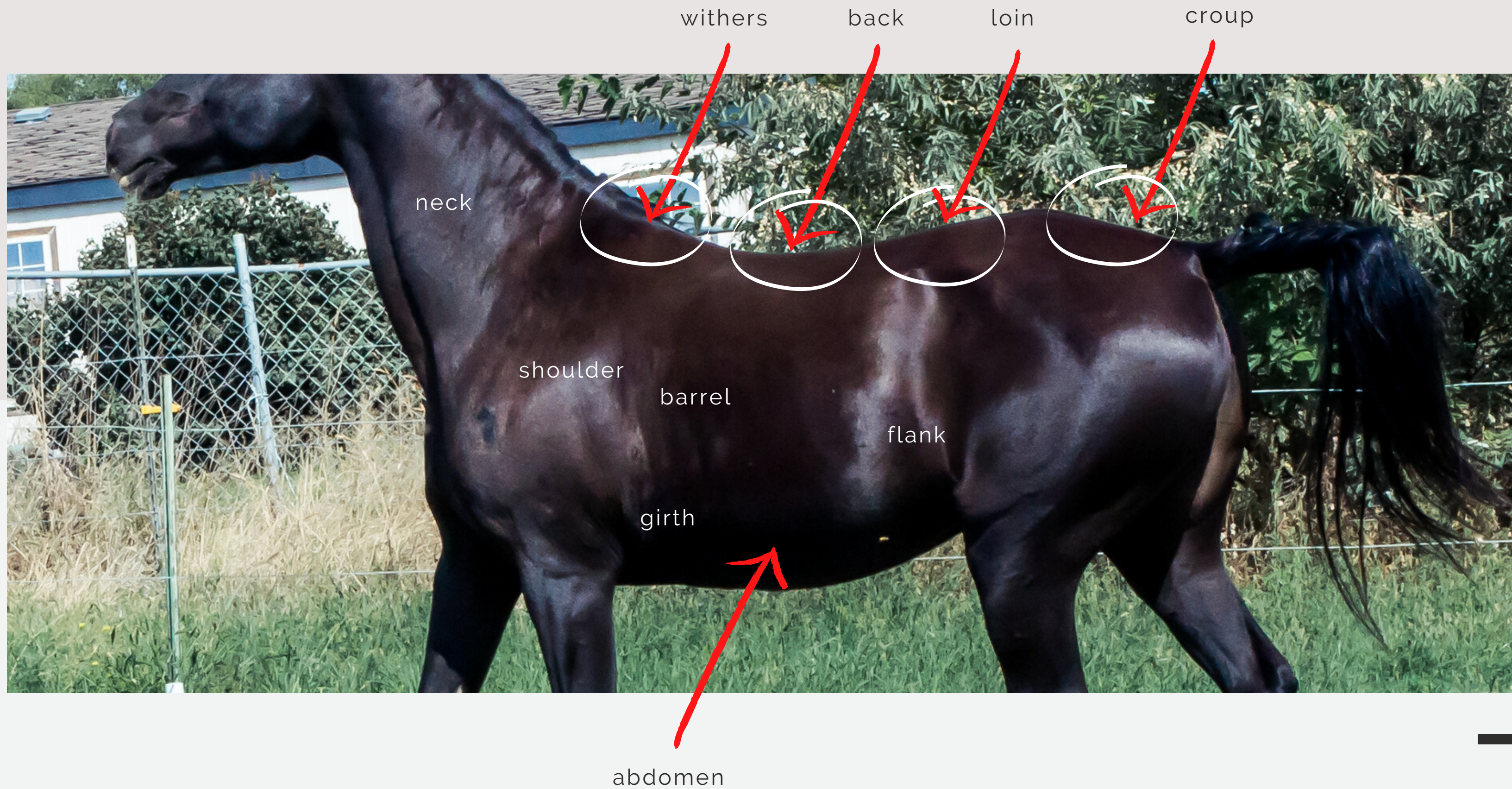

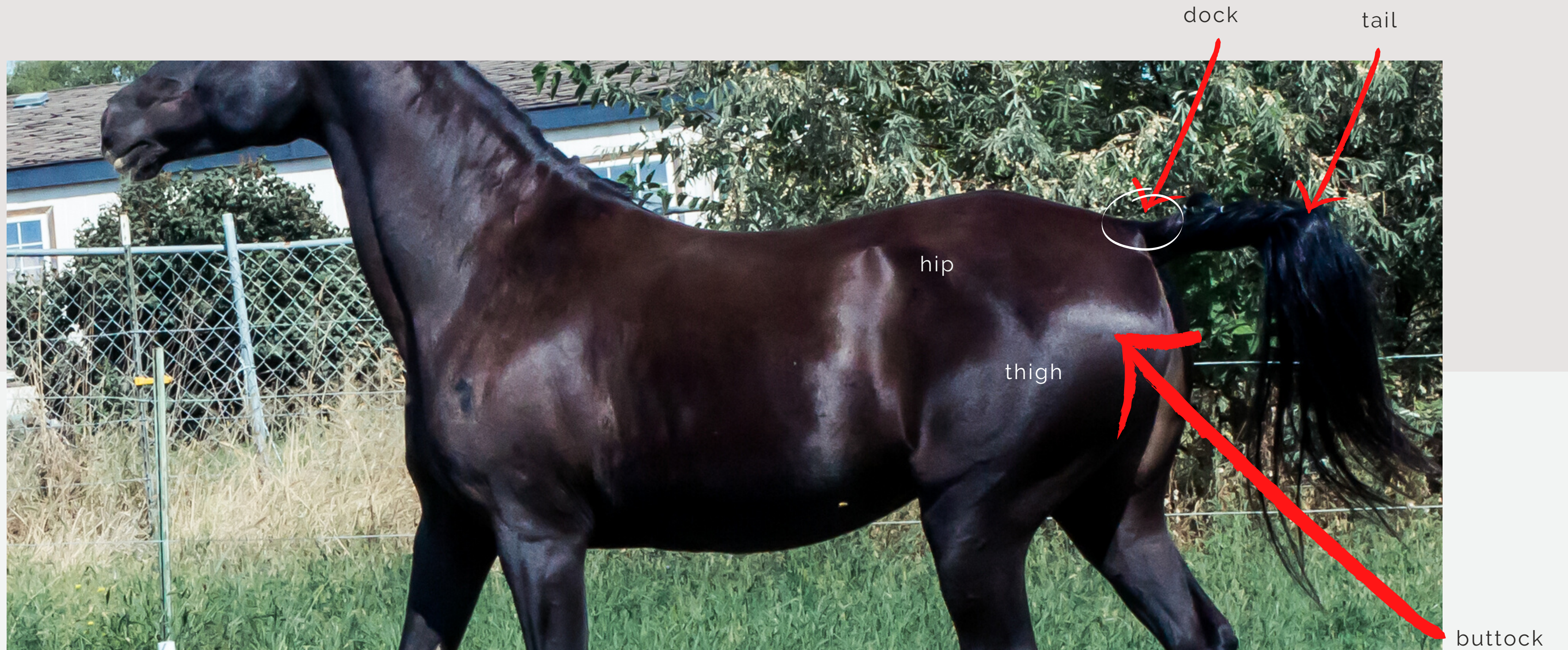

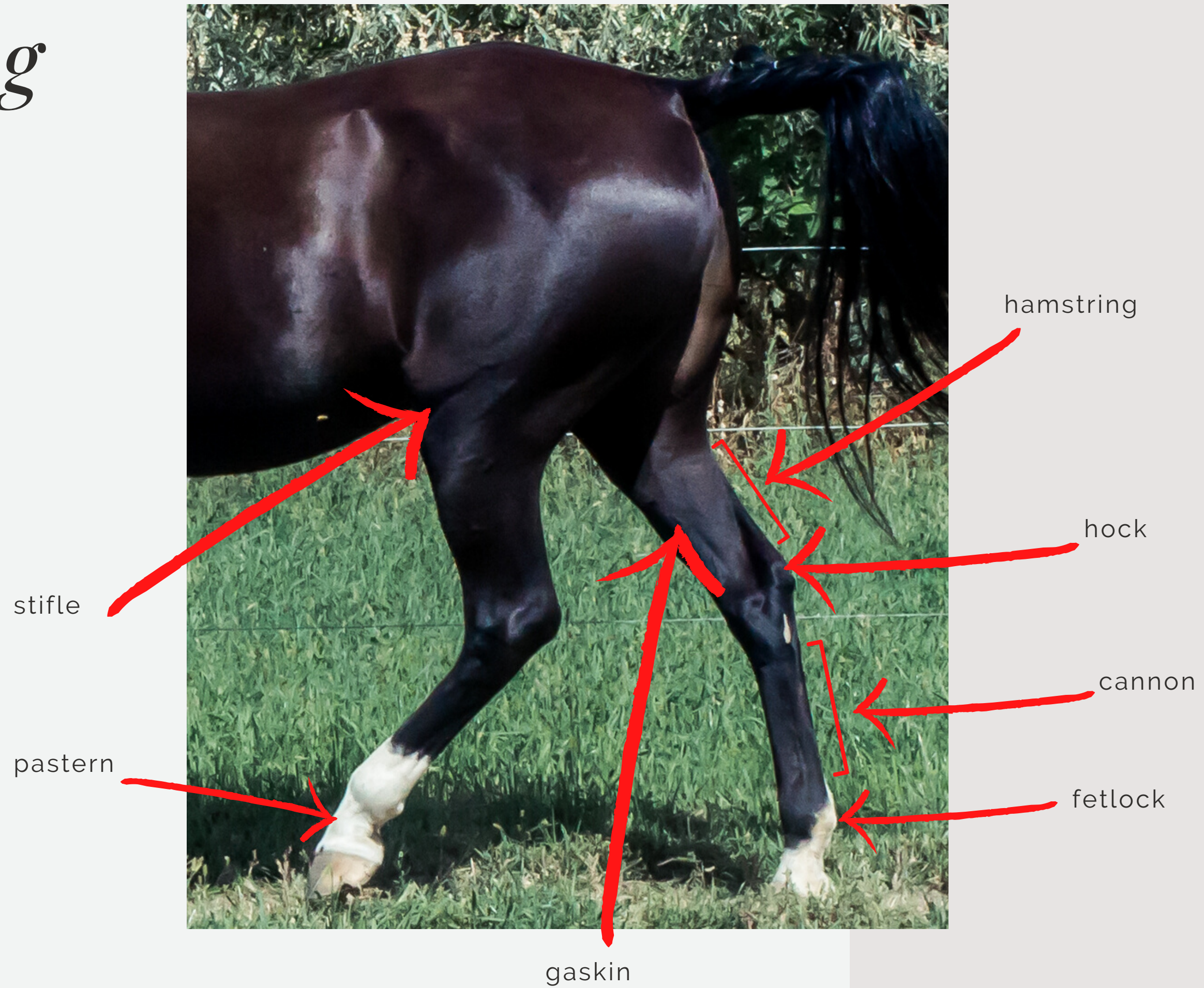


The barrel / body

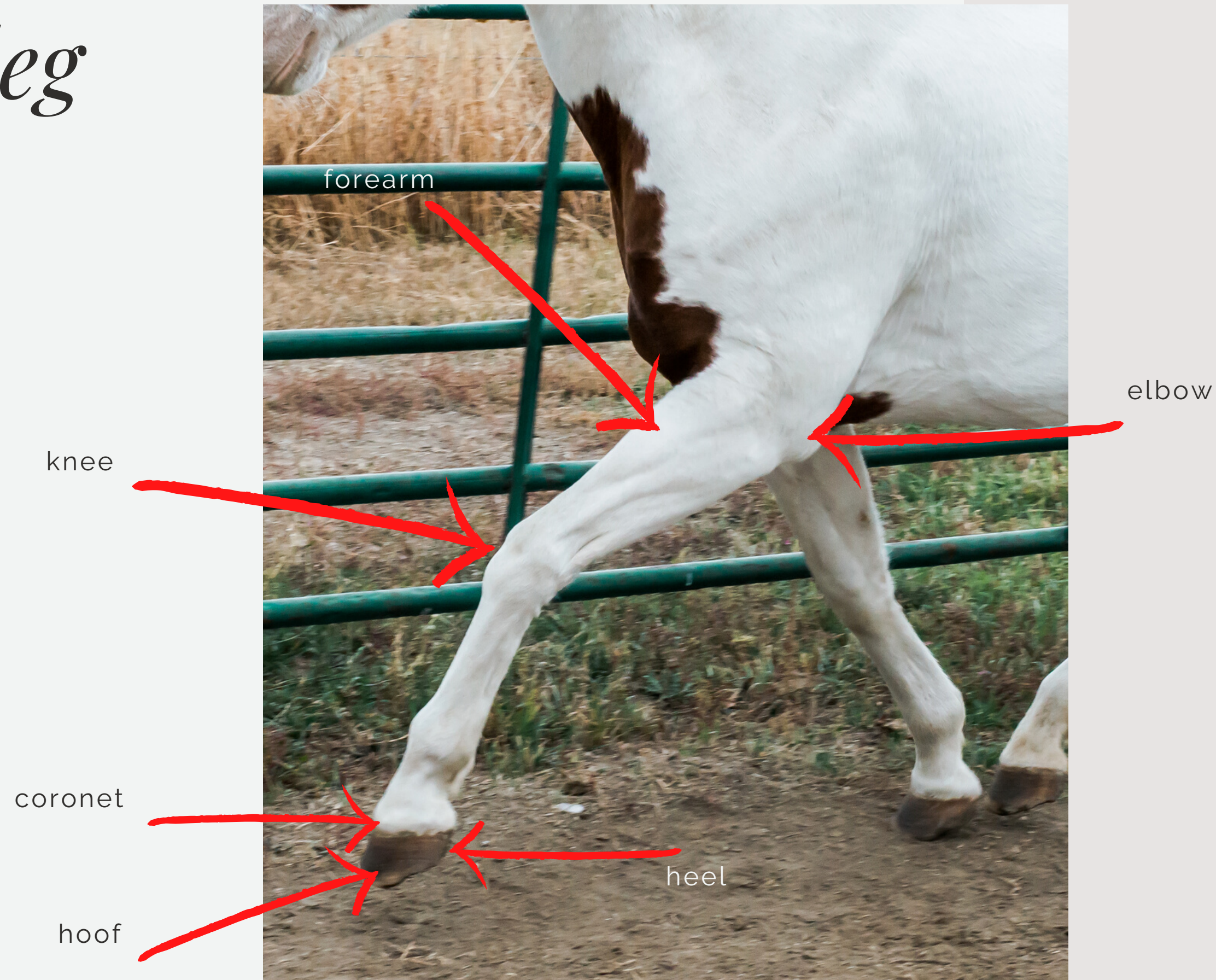


The hindquarters

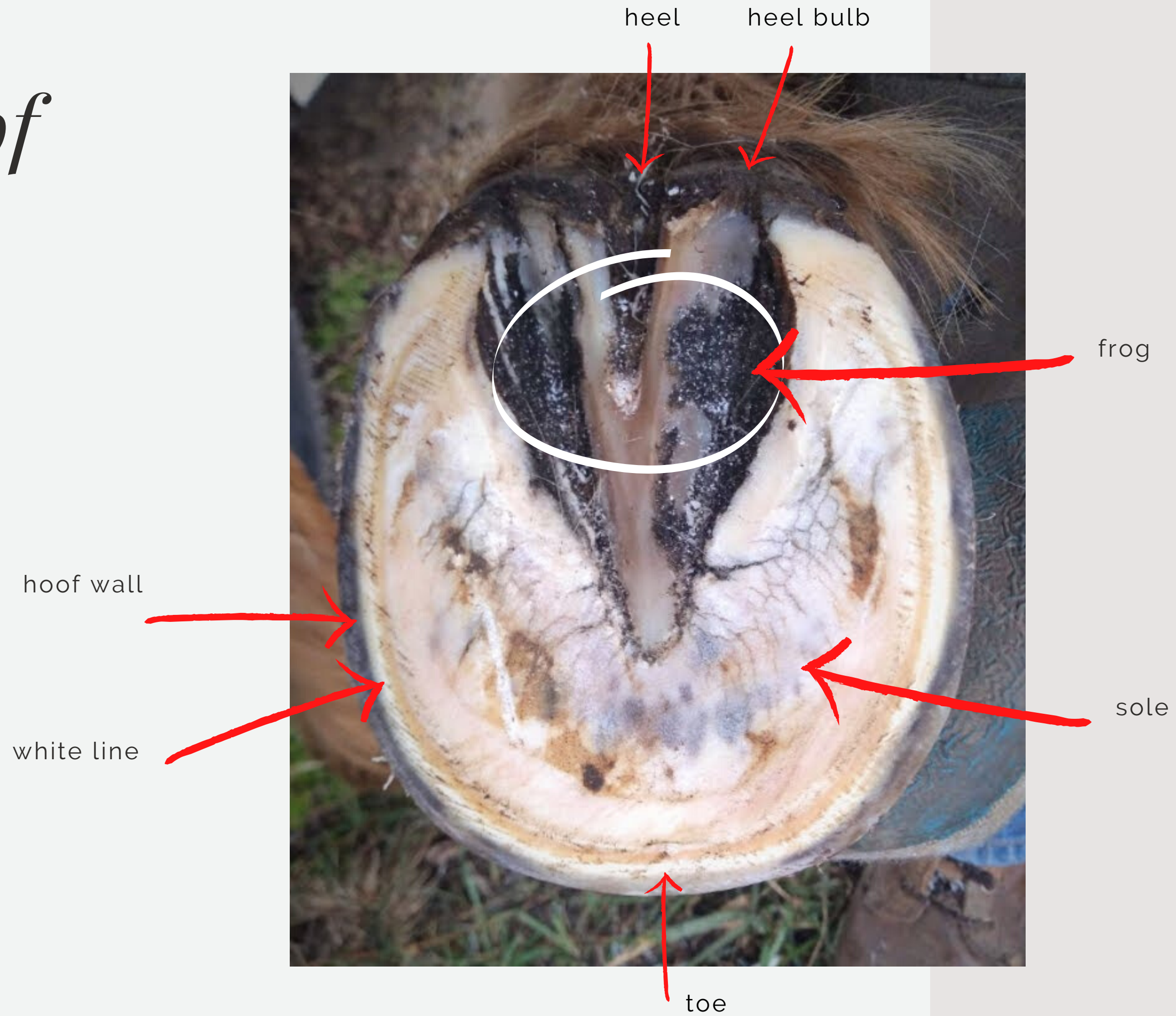
